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Post-Operative Instructions for Ankle Fracture

- You should already have an appointment for suture removal in about 2-3 weeks. If you do not, be sure to call the office.
 You have a sterile splint on your leg. Keep it dry.
- 3. Elevate affected leg with two pillows UNDER THE ANKLE as tolerated. Discontinue when comfortable.
- 4. Use ice for 3-4 days. You should use it at least 3 to 4 times daily for 15 to 20 minutes each. Apply as soon as possible.
- 5. You should be non weight bearing with crutches for 4-6 weeks after surgery. Then you may progress to weight bearing as tolerated.
